He died in Barcelona in 1926, run over by a trolley Antoni Gaudí, the man "La Pedrera" is a series of stone curtain walls calcareous on the exterior and painted on the interior They enclose an architectural structure of pillars and girders

Casa Milà (La Pedrera) In 1906 Gaudí received the commission from Pere Milá and his wife, Roser Segimon, to construct this large building with apartments He wanted a very original and exclusive building The building was so original that it resulted in many criticisms by the citizens of the time who only saw it as a mountain of rocks
